GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- 1. For 2019, the Council of Philadelphia Chapter No.1, NAWCC, plans to award one or more horological study grants with a value up to \$500 to students of horology. Membership in the NAWCC by applicants is preferred but not required. All award winners are encouraged but not required to help with educational and other activities at their home chapter meetings or, if they do not belong to a local chapter, to promote educational programs of other horological organizations through lectures, workshops and other means. Previous grant recipients may be eligible for a second scholarship at the Council's discretion.
- 2. Grants may be used only for tuition and registration fees for a course of study at a recognized School of Horology or an NAWCC Watch and Clock Traveling Workshop program. A listing of Schools of Horology and Traveling Workshop programs will be found on the NAWCC website.
- 3. Applications for 2019 scholarships must be received by the Scholarship Committee by October 15, 2018. Awards will be announced by December 1, 2018. Courses of study should be completed by December 31, 2019.
- 4. Grant monies will be paid directly to recognized Schools of Horology or course providers after the grantee is actually enrolled in the course of study for which the grant was requested.
- 5. Neither the NAWCC nor Chapter 1 assumes any responsibility for tuition, fees or for any other expenses incurred by the scholarship recipient above and beyond the stated amount awarded.
- 6. The Council of Chapter 1 will be solely responsible for all decisions regarding scholarship awards and reserves the right to accept or reject any application. The decisions of the Council of Chapter 1 with regard to the award of the scholarship(s) will be final and not subject to any challenge or recourse.
- 7. By submitting an application for a Scholarship Grant, the applicant acknowledges that the guidelines have been read, understood and accepted.
