Scholarship awards are given to promote horology and to benefit both chapter members and the chapter itself. After completing their course of study, scholarship awardees will be asked to help at chapter meetings, if possible, and to assist with other chapter activities.

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

During 2008, the Council of Chapter 1 plans to award horological study grants with a total value of up to \$1000 to current members of Chapter 1. All award winners will be expected to provide future service to the chapter. Previous grant recipients are not eligible to apply.

Grants may only be used for tuition and registration fees for a course of study at the NAWCC School of Horology or in a Field Suitcase Workshop Program

Applications for the 2008 scholarship must be received by the Scholarship Committee by December 31, 2008. The award will be announced by January 31, 2009. Courses of study must be completed by September 30, 2009.

Grant monies will be paid directly to the NAWCC School of Horology or the Field Suitcase Workshop Program after the grantee has actually enrolled in the course of study for which the grant was requested.

Neither the NAWCC nor Chapter 1 assumes any responsibility for tuition, fees or for any other expenses incurred by the scholarship recipient above and beyond the stated amount awarded.

The Council of Chapter 1 shall be solely responsible for all decisions regarding scholarship awards and reserves the right to accept or reject any application.
