SPEAKERS AT THE APRIL MEETING

For those of you who missed the last Chapter One meeting unfortunately missed two very good speakers as well. Andrew Kennedy's workshop on the repair of watch cases Part 2 was very well presented and was well received by the audience. Remarks praising the workshop topic and presentation were numerous and heartfelt. The Lecture on the tall case clocks in the Biggs Museum in Delaware by Ryan Grover was both informative and enjoyable. His presentation traced the history of several well-known Delaware clockmakers and though he himself was not an expert on clock making, he kept many of us who were thoroughly informed and entertained. A special thanks to Mike Allen who found and arranged the accommodations for these speakers.

MEETING FOR APRIL 1st 2012

The Meeting was a moderate success in that the numbers were down compared to the previous meeting in February. There were 103 advanced Registrations made, with 19 Early birds and 48 Walkins making a total of 170 members attending. Only 84 tables were sold, making it a bit less full than we would like. However, it made up for the smaller numbers with strong mart sales and Silent Auction action. We also picked up 13 new chapter members, bringing our total dues-paying membership to 376.
