The Best in Show. Do you have a watch, clock or horological related item? Why not bring it in to present in the Best of Show. This is a great way to educate other members. The winners will receive \$50 in Mart scrip to be used in the mart room. This can be carried over to future events if you don't use it the day you win.

Saturday Hands On Workshop The "One Day Class" for Saturday September 11th will be: "Pocket watch maintenance and repair for the beginning Watch Enthusiasts." This class is for the novice, it will involve: identifying the various parts and nomenclature of American pocket watches, methods of identifying the make, model and date of an American Pocket watch, a brief explanation of how a pocket watch works, removing the movement from the case, letting down the power; removing, cleaning and oiling and returning the balance; checking the winding mechanism; removing and returning the hands; removing and returning the dial; removing and returning the mainspring barrel; measuring the mainspring, cleaning it and replacing it in the barrel; oiling the mechanism. Hints as what to look for in buying a pocket watch. Participants should bring to the class the following items: An American pocket watch that is running, a pair of sharp watchmakers tweezers, a set of small watchmakers screw drivers, a light to illuminate your watch, an opotivisor or loupe, a small container to hold small parts like screws, etc., a touch oiler or similar devise for oiling your watch, and any other tools that you feel that you will need. If you do not have any of the following items they can be provided to you by the instructor for this class.
