President's Column

Our Annual Joint Chapter 11, 12, 141 Chapter Meeting and Mart held at the Woodsboro VFD Community Hall, Woodsboro MD, on April 22 was a success. The Mart had 27 tables sold and was attended by 71 members and guests. We all enjoyed Melvyn Kornspan's presentation on "The History of American Clocks Through 50 Years of Collecting."

This was our 20th Joint Chapter 11, 12, 141 Meeting and Mart held at the Woodsboro VFD Community Hall. Our first mart was held April 13, 1997. In 2006 and 2007 we held two marts each year, one in April and one in August. Earlier, Chapter 11 and 12 held Joint Meetings and Marts in April, 1997 at the Holiday Inn, Laurel, MD, and April, 1998 at the BWI Airport Comfort Inn.

Our February 12th meeting, at the Pickersgill Retirement Community, was well attended with 30 member and guests. There was a small mart with active trading. Sharon Harwood, assisted by her husband Herb, entertained us with her presentation on "Towers of Time." The tour started in the year 1088 with the Cosmic Engine. This was an astronomical observatory and clock tower designed by Su Song in China.

We continued to 15th century Germany for the start of the tower clock tour. It seems the year 1410 was a great year for tower clock construction. A number were installed in numerous cities and towns in Germany and the rest of Europe that year. Of interest was a tower clock with an alarm that alerted the time keeper 5 minutes before the hour so he could ring the bells on the hour. The alarm was necessary because the clock tower was constructed of wood and a candle was not allowed to be used for fear of fire. In Amsterdam, we heard the story of "Silly Jack", a tower clock that got it's name from inaccurate timekeeping. Our travels continued to Austria, Slovakia, and Switzerland.

We concluded with the astrological clocks of Strasbourg, France, (5 weights), Bern, Switzerland, and Prague in the Czech Republic. We certainly wish to thank Sharon and Herb for sharing their travels and interest in tower clocks with us.

Our next meeting will be June 11, 2017. The program will be "Machining Clock Parts" presented by Bill Bonta.

I must conclude on a sad note. Our long time member Michael (Mike) Eder died on February 22, 2017. Mike documented many of the tower clocks which were still in existence in Baltimore City and the surrounding area. Mike will be missed.
