JOE ORENS 301-340-6664 Thank you **David Kehne** for your February 11th presentation on the 9 inch Seth Thomas mantel clocks. The clocks, made between 1863 and 1890, are 9 inches tall and normally 3-4 inches in depth. There were four different models, a "Cottage" model with a flat top, a "Cabinet" model with a round or peaked top, and an "Octagon" model. All were available with a 30 hour or 8 day round plated movement, time only, time and strike, with or without an alarm. There were also various door treatments, usually with a mirror insert. Dave had all of the basic models with the exception of the peaked top model. A collection of all of the variations would be quite large.

Next came the **Woodsboro Joint Chapter 11, 12, 141 meeting** on April 21st. We had 51 members and guests attending and 13 table sold.

Betsy Stone, the leasing administrator and tour guide for the Bromo Seltzer Arts Tower in Baltimore, MD presented "A Timely Tale", a comprehensive history of the Bromo Seltzer clock, the tower, and Mr. Emerson, the man responsible for the Baltimore landmark. Her presentation was very interesting and well received.

We also learned that the Woodsboro Fire Department is in the process of selling the community center where our meetings are held. They expect to finalize the sale in August, 2018.

The Woodsboro fire hall, which is about 1 mile, away does have facilities which could host a small joint meeting. However with the low turnout and the monetary loss from the current meeting, a decision has to be made as to whether we should continue the event.

The July 10th meeting program, *"Tools You Have Made to Repair a Clock or Watch,"* should bring out some interesting items and experiences among our members. I hope will be able to participate and share your wisdom with the group.
