President's Column

Twenty two (22) members and guests attended our June 10th meeting at the Pickersgill Retirement Community.

Sadly, I had to announce the passing of our beloved President, Don Buck, who died suddenly May 31st while undergoing chemotherapy treatment for cancer. Don was an avid supporter of Chapter 11, and Chapter 1, as well as the National Association. He left this world much to soon, and we will miss him. With the office now vacant, as Vice-President, I became President of Chapter 11 and Tom Koluch agreed to fill in as Vice-President. We will hold an election in August to confirm Tom as Vice-President. There is still the need to fill the Secretary vacancy, please consider becoming OUR SECRETARY at the next meeting.

Our program was "Tools You Have Made to Repair a Clock or Watch". I would like to thank the following presenters who shared with us tools that they have made to do clock or watch repairs. Tom Mostyn began the program by showing us a screw driver he modified (with a V in the blade and a hook on the side) that could be used to push or pull a pivot shaft into the pivot hole in the plate and showed us a pendulum with an adjustable bob that could be used to determine the correct pendulum length, for a missing pendulum.

Tom Koluch showed, and demonstrated, a mainspring winder that he made. The winder, and its attachments, was well made and capable of handling almost any size clock mainspring. George Hudson took half credit for Tom Mostyn's pivot pusher, since he had an identical tool, and full credit for his modified pliers, dished on one side for removing taper pins. Eric Kramer showed us a watch cup holder that he had. Dave Gorrell spoke about the Traveling Workshops sponsored by the NAWCC, see page 28 of the May/June 2018 NAWCC Mart.

Although not a tool, Ed Butler showed a clock from the TSS Transylvania, a North Atlantic passenger ship, requisitioned as an armed merchant cruiser when WWII began and sunk by a German U-boat off the Irish coast. He also had a fire alarm box that, when activated, sent a signal to its headquarters, giving the location of the box, and thus the location of the fire.

Our August 12th program is "My Summer Horological Find". Good luck in finding you find, and consider bring both you "Find" and a guest to the meeting.
