The Secretary's minutes were approved as published to the membership. The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

President Dugan awarded a plaque from the Chapter, in appreciation for the many years of service and dedication to NAWCC, to out going President Wayne Herrmann. The plaque has the National NAWCC logo with Wayne's name and national number engraved on it, along with his years served as Vice President, President, and Regional General Chairman. The last line, and quite fitting, is a quote, "You're a good man, Herrmann," which Wayne heard often from a Chapter member, dear friend, and his clock repair instructor, the late Wiley Millison.

President Dugan announced to Chapter members that the National award of Fellow was presented to Ruth Herrmann by National President James Coulson at the River Cities Regional held in Omaha, Nebraska, May 20th and 21st.

The very interesting guided tour of a special exhibit, "It's About Time!" at the Linda Hall Library arranged by Vice President Roger Schroeder, was discussed and reported to be an extra ordinary display. Roger, Darrell Carr, Bill Dugan, Wayne and Ruth Herrmann viewed this exhibit June 4th. One of the clocks on exhibit was a long case clock purchased by Herbert and Linda Hall from a dealer in Edinburgh, Scotland, in 1897. This clock has been restored by Chapter member, Jerry Faier. The exhibit contained very early and rare books on the history of clocks and clockmaking. The paper quality and printing techniques were amazing for the time period.

Our one and only Show & Tell item for this meeting was shown by "Digger" O'Dell. This was a wall clock with Waterbury movement in an unusual case. The front part unfolded to
