The presentation will be a very informative picture show describing the Hanford Nuclear site and career path for Mr. Dennis A. Armstrong, during the Cold War years. The presentation covers the facilities and production cycle from fuel preparation, reactors, separations processes and final product fabrication. No clocks or watches were harmed during the preparation of this program.

About Our Speaker: Mr. Dennis A. Armstrong has made significant engineering contributions at the Hanford Nuclear site to a broad spectrum of production and design activities including

early defense weapons manufacturing, waste management and commercial reactor design. Before retirement, he led the Safety Related mechanical equipment operating license qualification program for the Columbia Generating Station 1,100-megawatt commercial nuclear power plant.
