**Preregistration.** If you preregister and plan to pay when you get there for the mart and request either a table or lunch and don't show, you will need to pay by mail after the meeting because we will still have the cost for the lunches and tables.

The Luncheon Speaker will be: Dave Gorrell. The topic is "French Clock Production"

The Workshop Speaker will be: Dan Nied. The topic is "Identifying and correcting binding issues in clocks and watches". Dan Nied of York Time Institute will demonstrate various ways of identifying and correcting binding issues in clocks and watches. Using a variety of tools such as the depthing tool and rounding up machine, Dan will demonstrate ways to correct this sometimes vexing problem. While binding is often associated with the gear train, there are other areas where this can be an issue. This is an area that can be easily overlooked during a service, especially when it sometimes happens at seemingly random times during the run cycle of the timepiece. Dan will demonstrate how careful observation during the service process can identify potential binding issues and how to determine the best approach to correct them.

**Saturday Hands On Workshop.** There will be no charge for the class. The topic for the One Day Class on May 11<sup>th</sup> will be "We will be working on the Project clock for the National Crafts Contest. We hope to complete the following: Re-glaze the mirror, marbleize the six columns, clean and bush the Movement, adjust the verge, and replace the back. This will involve several groups

working at once on these various projects. We will also look at straightening the pivot on a Chronometer balance wheel."

For the May 18<sup>th</sup> One-Day class, we will gold leaf the tops of the six columns, the Floral Basket top, and the ball feet. The clock will then be reassembled and in running condition. The case will receive one last coat of shellac, and the dial will be affixed. The remainder of the class will be devoted to participant projects and problems.

As usual, the last hour of class time will be devoted to "Open Bench" where participants are encouraged to bring their current Clock and/or Watch problems to the class for suggestions or solutions.
