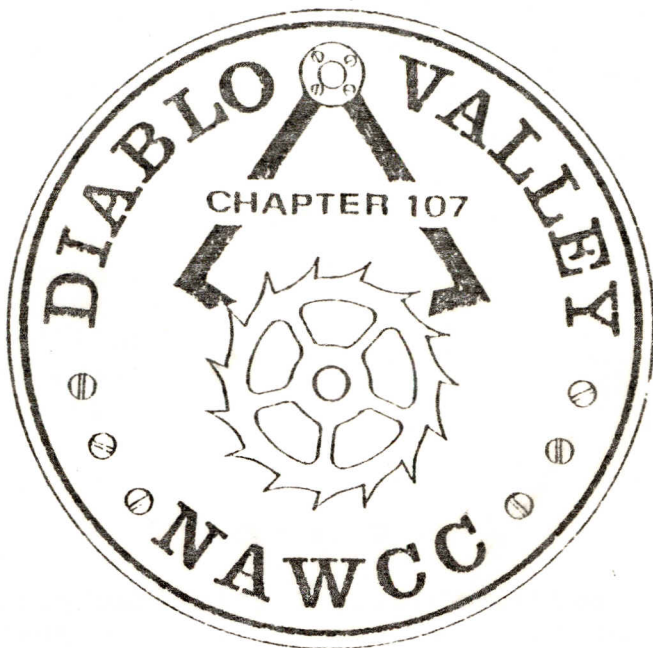

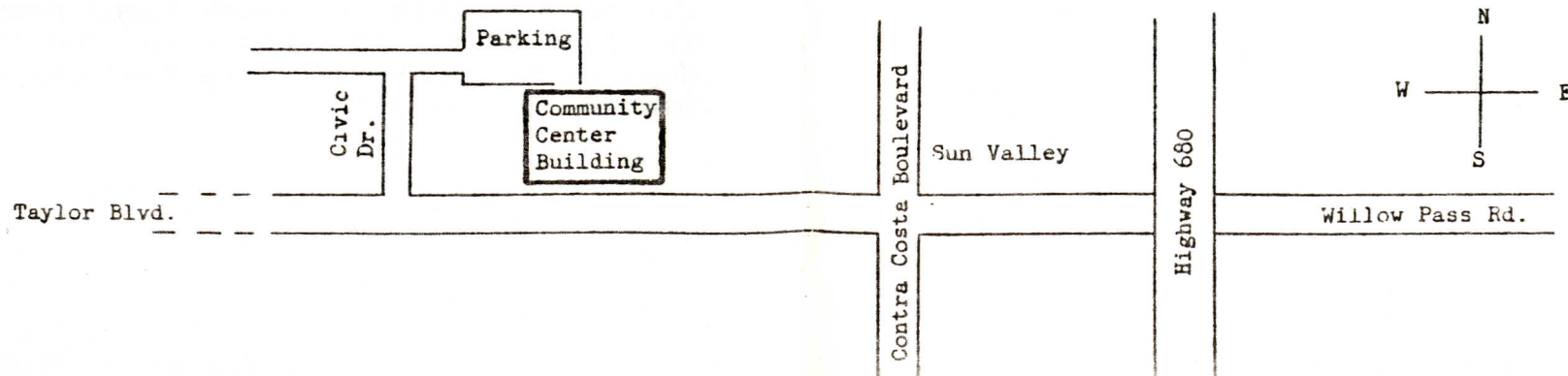

TIPS

Lacquering.....

If brass weights and dials tarnish quickly, lacquer with 30% lacquer and 70% lacquer thinner. This mixture is so thin, it can be brushed on without showing brush marks. It is preferable, however, to spray or dip the article to be lacquered. WARNING.....
BE SURE YOU USE THE SAME BRAND LACQUER AS THINNER, TO ELIMINATE CRYSTALLIZATION.
