### President's Column

Our June 5th breakfast meeting at the Pickersgill Retirement Community had 26 members and guests in attendance. We were joined by several members of the community for the program.

The program, presented by George Hudson, was "E. Howard 1687 - Story of the Tower Clock." George had initially published an article in the NAWCC Bulletin (October, 2006, Vol. 48/5, No. 364, pgs. 544-549) on his restoration of the clock. George had done additional research on the history of the clock and incorporated that information into his presentation. The program was enjoyed by all.

It was suggested that we change the Chapter 11 meeting dates to a more consistent schedule. We subsequently decided to meet on the 2nd Sunday of even months. We came up with the following schedule which incorporates this change, with a few exceptions. The exceptions take into consideration that the April Joint 11, 12 and 141 meeting at Woodsboro counts as a Chapter 11 meeting. Also, since many of our members attend the Southern Ohio, and Eastern States Regionals, we will make adjustments to accommodate these events when there is a conflict with the 2nd Sunday, even month date.

The Chapter 11 meeting schedule is as follows; August, 28, 2016 (avoids conflict with Eastern States Regional, August 12-13, 2016); October 9, 2016; December 11, 2016; February 12, 2017; Saturday April 22, 2017 (the Chapter 11, 12, 141 Joint Woodsboro Meeting) and June 11, 2017.

The Program for our August 28th meeting will consist of two segments. The first will be "My Summer Horological Find" and the second will be "The Spouse's Tale." We hope to obtain both positive and/or negative feedback, from the wife, about her husband's hobby. SINCE WE ARE ENCOURAGING ALL SPOUSES (OR SIGNIFICANT OTHER) TO ATTEND, THEY WILL HAVE FREE ADMISSION TO THIS EVENT.

We are still in need of filling the Chapter Secretary position. There will also be a short Executive Board Meeting after the chapter meeting to discuss filling this position and to obtain ideas for programs for future meetings.
