Our program was "My Summer Horological Find". The presenters were as follows;

Frank Goad brought two electric clocks, circa 1930, that he obtained at a regional at no cost. He stated that no-cost clocks were his favorite. The first was a Hammond clock, circa 1928-40, that had a manual start lever. The second was a wood cased clock without its motor, but Frank thought unique because of its maker O. B. McClintock. McClintock is usually thought of as a maker of large outdoor clocks, usually designed for banks or public buildings. There is and example on the wall of the NAWCC Museum building in Columbia, PA.

Tom Mostyn brought an Ansonia steeple clock that he had purchased at auction about 15 years ago. Tom stripped what veneer was left and applied new rosewood veneer, explaining the problem of working with rosewood veneer on curved surfaces. The result was a beautifully veneered clock.

Bill Hiler, a machinist by trade, brought some tools for his Derbyshire lathe. He showed and explained the use of the file rest, milling attachment, and screw cutter. He said the tools were in excellent shape and reasonably priced.

Bill Miller had a small French desk clock, circa 1900, marked "Lancel" and "Made in France". It also had "JF" in a cartouche on the 30 hour watch type, non-jeweled, movement. A pocket watch similar to the desk model is illustrated in Shugart's "Complete Guide to Watches", No. 29, 2009, pg.597. It is described as "Wandering hour hands, 12 hands appear one at a time and move across minutes sector, the 12 hands are on 3 star wheels, pin lever escapement." Bill's clock is missing the lower portion of the dial below the minute sector, exposing the star wheels.

Bob Butler had a 1910 rosewood veneered wall clock with ebonized moldings, short drop with and octagon head. The clock had a Waterbury movement, but was cased in England. As a final action, Bob sold the clock to Dave Kehne who said that although he did not bring a clock, he is taking one home. **2019** Important

It was time and strike with an 8 day fusee movement, had brass gears between wood plates and was circa 1870-80. It also had the original carved bone hands and the original leather bellows. The clock did need some servicing as it was not always cuckooing correctly.
