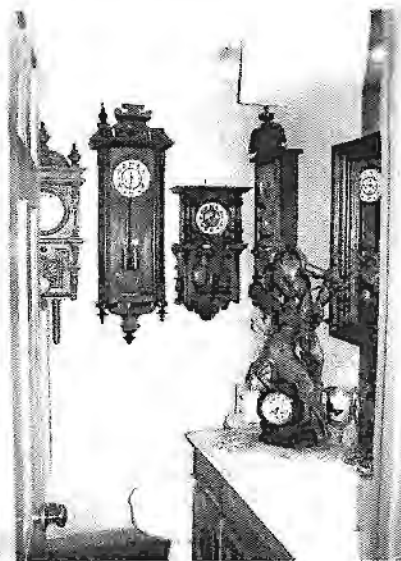


Chapter 36 is blessed with many wonderful cooks, once again manifest in the festive holiday dinner offerings.
