October Tech Topics:


Operation of a "Micrometer" simply counts revolutions of a threaded spindle to establish a linear dimension. Inch series micrometers employ 40 threads to an inch (40 pitch) which yields 0.025 inch advancement per spindle


rotation. The spindle is divided into 25 equal divisions each yielding a measurement to 0.001 inch.

The following picture has a micrometer reading of 0.178 inch.



Similarly, **metric** micrometers use a screw pitch of 0.5 millimeters which yields 0.5 millimeters per revolution. The beveled edge of the thimble is divided into fifty equal parts, with each line representing 0.01mm.

The following picture has a METRIC micrometer reading of 5.78 mm.
