Reports: Charlie Banks reported that all Mart Tables for the Fl. Regional Feb. 1-5 have been sold. Over 1000 have pre-registered.

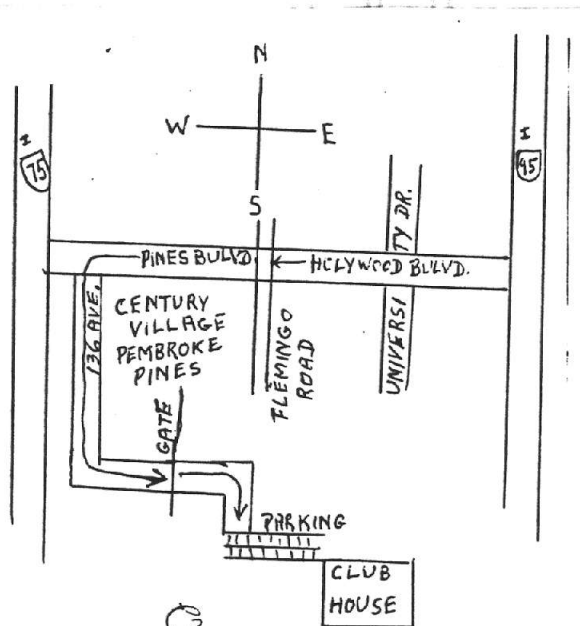
Joe Cohen spoke briefly on the 1998 Fl. Regional to be hosted by Chapter 60 and sister Chapter 154 Daytona Beach.
