An enthusiastic discussion ensued on a Herschede clock that had been repaired for the historical society. This discussion involved related history on Herschede, Colonial, Howard-Miller, Charles L Sligh, Ridgeway, Keininger and Zeeland, MI.

Show and Tell (X)

An un-named member brought in a novelty watch with suggestive two-gender positions for the hour-symbols. It was very educational. And entertaining.

John Wagner presented a Waltham (he was erroneously informed that the monthly letter was W) plated, 15-jewel pocket-watch.

Bob Miller brought in an Ansonia #11 Jeweler's standing regulator movement from the late 1800's. Its case is ~ 8-foot tall with 3 mercury-filled glass-tubes for the pendulum. The weight (time-only movement) is ~ 6 pounds..

Jason Stanley brought in a Seth Thomas pendulum (large-rod) and was looking at suggestions on repair. An interesting aspect of this clock was that it has two-springs to drive the single-train movement.

Paul Kwiatkowski shared with us a collection of "quasi" pocket-watches, eg a pedometer, volt-meter, pressure-gauge and other items that were designed to look like pocket-watches.
