They have both given so much of themselves to all of us. Thanks guys! During our brief annual meeting we reelected all officers and directors, plus we officially voted in Chuck Montrose as a director (though he had always been defacto). And thanks to those involved in making the party possible, including John Greeney, Chuck and Gail Montrose, Mark Nathanson, and, as always, Bill Clarke for his tireless coordinating work.

As you put your new calendar up on the wall, be sure to include our **February 17 "Workshop" Meeting**. Bill Clarke will be designing a digital clock that can also be read at night. Specs: The clock must large enough to see and must dim at night to allow sleep (as well as keeping accurate time). Bill will work though the details of keeping time, displaying time, setting the time (including DST), adjusting the rate as well as the mechanicals. Mike Graham will take us through assembling and replacing a 400-day suspension spring, using the Horolover manual and assorted alignment techniques. Paul Nicholson will show us how to create parts on a wood lathe. And, as a bonus, we may have a special visitor who will take us through one of his popular demos. This workshop promises to be a real learning experience.

As a reminder, the winter semester for the clock classes is starting on January 18. If you haven't taken the beginner's class taught by Bill Clarke, I highly recommend it. And the advanced class, overseen by Mike Graham and myself, is a bunch of guys (and gals) getting together as we work on our favorite clock projects ... so come and have fun and make good friends. 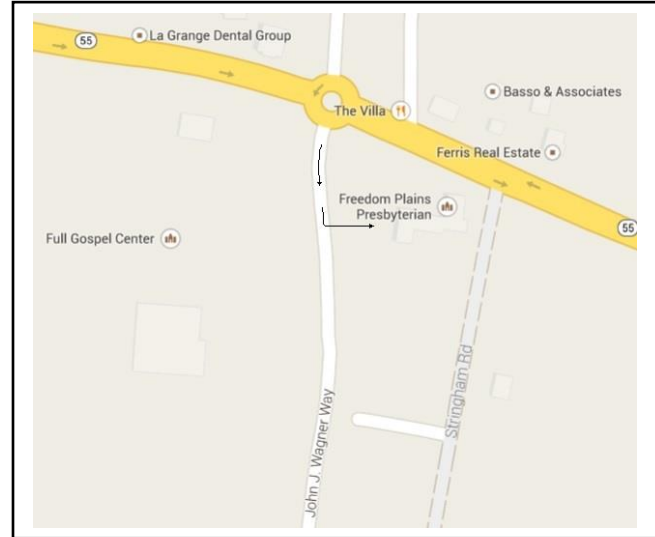
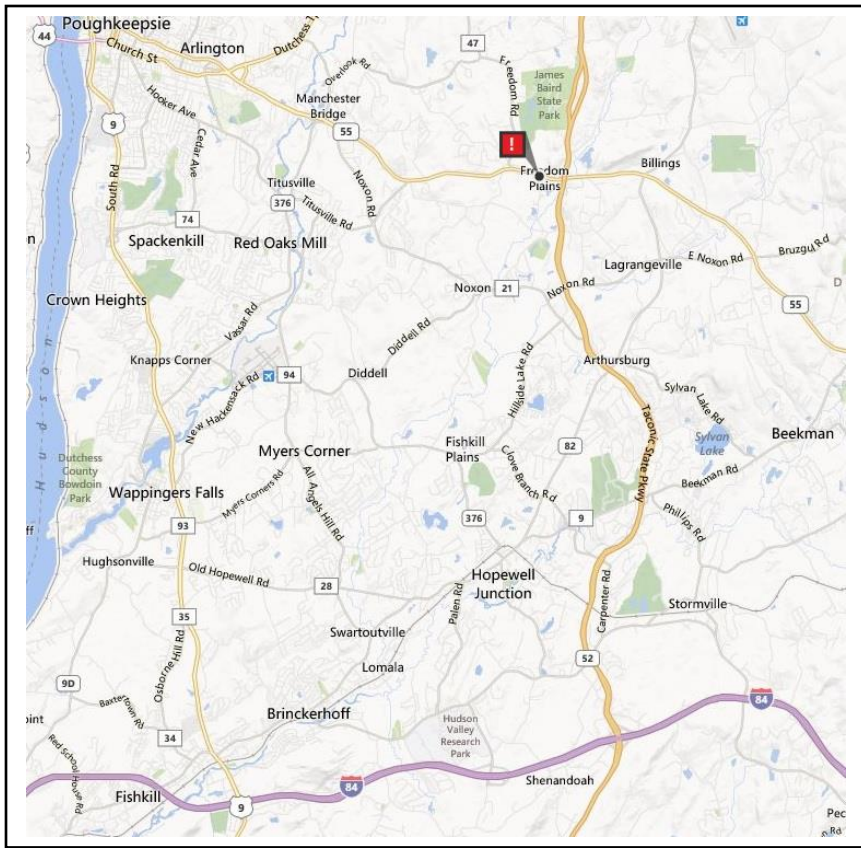

From the Taconic State Parkway: Take the “Poughkeepsie/Route 55/West” exit. Proceed west on 55 to the traffic circle at Stringham Road (about 0.3 miles). The circle is *just after* the large white church, on the left. Proceed $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the circle to enter Stringham Road, then turn left to enter the parking lot.

From US 9: At Poughkeepsie, take the “44/55 East” exit. In about 2 miles, bear right to stay on 55 East. In about 5.5 miles, you will see the large white church on the right. Proceed $\frac{1}{4}$ of the way around the circle that is *just before* the church to enter Stringham Road, then turn left to enter the parking lot.

From I-84: Exit onto US 9 and travel about 12 miles, then follow the directions above. Or, exit onto the Taconic State Parkway, travel about 9 miles, then follow the directions above.

➔ The meeting room is on the west side of the church, adjacent to the parking lot.
